Methodological Approach for Real Social Effects in Adult Education (MARS)


This project wants to help reduce the contradictory emotional states such as violence, anger, despair and panic experienced by individuals in crisis. The project aims to help these individuals contribute to produce different competencies and to improve their literacy skills in terms of digital, health, information and economy by creating adult education modules that intend to guide adult educators and good practices for LTT activities.

The target audiences of the project are adults and stakeholder participants gathered in 3 groups with a positive ambience to contribute to the project:

1. Trainers, trainees and institution managers working in adult education centres where pilot applications will be carried out;

2. Adult education institutions, nongovernmental organisations, associations, institutions volunteering with adult audiences, decision-makers, local governments and press organs.

3. All kinds of institutions and adults who will benefit from the project's results.



Our Role

AcrossLimits was tasked with designing and creating the project's e-learning platform.

This platform includes information resources comprised of 12 training modules for individuals to assist them in recognising the de facto rules within their personal, regional, national, and international contexts, raising awareness, and acquiring the necessary behavioural skills in the crisis management process. Robotics4EU

Boosting wider adoption of Robotics in Europe

Robotics4EU is a 3-year-long project funded under the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme, which aims to ensure more widespread adoption of (AI-based) robots in healthcare, inspection and maintenance of infrastructure, agri-food, and agile production.

Robotics4EU will create and empower the EU-wide responsible robotics community representing robotics innovators from companies and academia in the four application areas, as well as citizens / users and policy / decision-makers by:

- Raising awareness about nontechnological aspects of robotics by organising community building and cocreation events bringing together the robotics community and citizens;
- Advocating for the responsible robotics among all stakeholders' groups;
- Developing a responsible robotics maturity assessment model and bringing the project results to the standardisation bodies.

Our Role

AcrossLimits was tasked with recruiting participants in Malta to host a GlobalSay citizen discussion about the role of robotics in society.

Each GlobalSay partner had to recruit 10 hosts locally in their country. These were chosen based on a range of criteria intended to ensure the diversity of the hosts. Each meeting had a total of 5-8 participants, including the host. These were friends, family, colleagues, and acquaintances. The meeting took place anywhere the host wanted, using the GlobalSay platform, and lasted between 1-2 hours.

AcrossLimits recruited the hosts via social media outreach with custom visuals, a press release published in a local newspaper, word of mouth, and our network of contacts. Once recruited, AcrossLimits coordinated the hosts and their meetings, collected data and forwarded it to the project's organisers.
